

## **QAS DRESS CODE 2009-2010**

### **Girls**

Jumper - (grades K-5)	Berry and gray plaid.
Skirt - (grades 6-8)	Berry and gray plaid. Skirt may not be rolled at the waist. Length of jumpers/skirts may be no shorter than three inches from the top of the kneecap.
Blouse - (grades K-5)	White, long or short sleeve, round collar or polo shirt – no insignia. Blouse should be tucked in at all times.
- (Grades 6-8)	Oxford cloth, white long or short sleeve, button-down collar or polo shirt – no insignia except QAS initials. Blouse/shirt should be tucked in at all times.
Pants - (optional)	Solid gray or blue. May not be worn under jumper or skirt.
Belt	Required
Socks	Required. Footed, solid, opaque gray, white or berry tights may be worn under socks in cold weather.
Shorts	Recommended under jumper or skirt. Permitted year round. When worn as uniform, shorts must be at least as long or longer than the tip of the longest finger when standing relaxed with arms at sides.
Jewelry	Wristwatches, ball or lobe pierced earrings, one bracelet, one ring, and one necklace. No dangling earrings.
Cosmetics	Base make-up (foundation to cover blemishes) only is permitted (no eye shadow, mascara, eye liner, lipstick, etc.). Only clear or light color (if in doubt, ask the administration before wearing) nail polish is permitted. No tattoos of any kind.

### **Boys**

Pants/shorts	Solid gray or blue
Shirt	White, long or short sleeve knit – no insignia except QAS initials. Shirt should be tucked in at all times.
Belt	Required
Socks	Required
Jewelry	Wristwatch, one ring, one necklace, one bracelet. No earrings or tattoos of any kind permitted.
Hair	Length of the hair will not exceed the top of the collar in the rear nor fall below the eyebrows in the front

### **Boys and Girls**

Hair	Must be kept neat and clean. No style or color that detracts from the learning environment will be accepted.
Sweatshirt - (optional)	Gray QAS sweatshirt or hoodie worn over shirt/blouse. Grade 7 & 8 students may wear gray or maroon QAS hoodie.
Grade level/activity T-shirt	Is considered part of that grade's uniform and should be

(i.e. 8 <sup>th</sup> gr, Stu. Co., etc.)	tucked in at all times. Grade level T-shirts may be worn on assigned day. Activity T-shirts may be worn the day of the activity.
Undershirt	White (no lettering or designs permitted)
Shoes	School shoes or athletic shoes (canvas, vinyl or leather). No athletic shoes with spikes.
Jackets/coats	Should be removed upon arrival.
Scout Uniform	May be worn on the day of the meeting.
PE uniform	<u>shorts</u> (recommended purchase through the 8 <sup>th</sup> grade fundraiser) must be at least as long or longer than the tip of the longest finger when standing relaxed with arms at sides, plain <u>white T-shirt</u> (girls may wear navy blue or maroon T-shirt), and <u>athletic shoes</u> (black soles are strongly discouraged) Sweatshirt - gray QAS sweatshirt Sweatpants – gray, blue or white only (optional for cooler or outdoor weather) Nylon Warm-Ups (track pants) - navy blue or black only (optional for cooler or outdoor weather)
Cool/cold weather	Jackets/coats are not to be worn in the classrooms. Leggings may be worn under skirts/jumpers for warmth. Boots worn during inclement weather are to be removed upon arrival.

Except for identification purposes, children are not permitted to write on any part of their uniform at any time.

### **Out of Uniform Day**

Occasionally the students will have a day when uniforms do not have to be worn. On these days, there are certain guidelines the students must follow:

1. Shorts must meet the length requirement outlined for uniform shorts, shoulders must be covered (shirts must have sleeves).
2. No pajama bottoms or boxers and no inappropriate lettering or logo.
3. Shirt must be long enough to come over the waistband of pants.
4. No temporary color and/or dye on the hair.
